

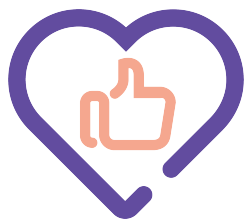
The new Universal Library Offers aim to connect communities, improve wellbeing and promote equality through learning, literacy and cultural activity.

Culture and Creativity

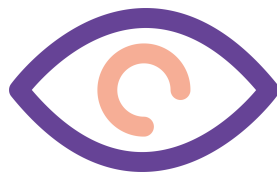
Explore, Create, Participate
